

GETTING STARTED WITH **hoopla**

hoopla is a digital media platform that offers access to an extensive collection of eMedia, including eBooks, eAudiobooks, eComics, eVideos, and music to download from anywhere you can access the web. It's totally free. What's cool about **hoopla** is that what you see can be checked out immediately. There is no waiting in a queue. If you see something you want, you can snap it up that instant.

hoopla permits Lancaster citizens to download up to ten [10] titles per library card each month. **hoopla** can be accessed for *free* on most Apple, Android, Kindle, Kindle Fire, and Windows computers or devices.

Requirements:

1. Users must live in Lancaster.
2. Have a Library card issued by Thayer Memorial Library that begins with 28128.
3. Have internet access.
4. Have a Windows, Apple, Android, Amazon, or Roku compatible device.

How can I start using **hoopla**?

1. If you wish to apply for library membership or want to renew your membership, follow this [link](#).
2. If you live in Lancaster and already have a library membership that *does not* start with 28128, contact the Library Director by following this [link](#).
3. If you already have a library card issued by Thayer Memorial Library:
 - a. Go to Thayer Memorial Library's [website](#).
 - b. Find the "Digital Resources" card located under the slider, and click on "Details."
 - c. Find the "**hoopla**" logo and click on it. To create an account, click the "Get Started Today" button near the top and in the middle of the page.
 - d. Create an account by providing your Email address and Password, read the [terms and conditions](#) and [privacy policy](#), and click on "Agree."
 - e. On the list that follows, choose "Thayer Memorial Library."

- f. Provide a library barcode number beginning with 28128.
- g. Click “DONE.”
