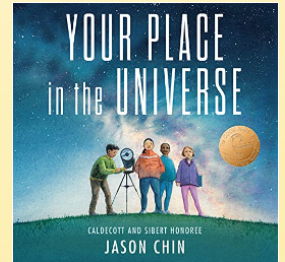
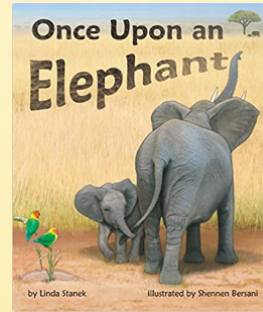
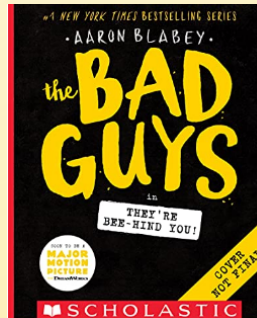
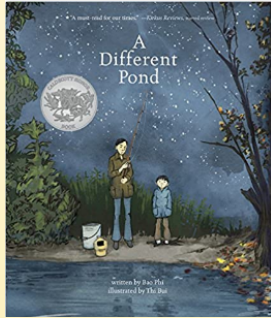
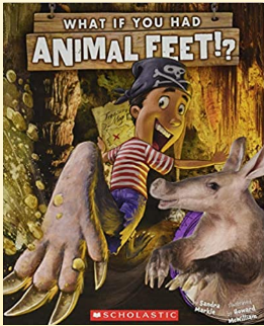


READ to succeed
